Booking Terms & Conditions

A, Deposits & Reservations

As stated on booking form, a non returnable deposit of £20 for the charter of the vessel must be **sent 10 days before date of trip**, unless buffet catering or barbecue trips are booked then a **50% non returnable deposit of the total cost of the charter is required 10 days before. And the balance for the charter if paid by cheque is due 5 days before trip or cash prior to departure.**

B, Skipper's Control, Terms & Conditions

Before & during the trip the vessel shall remain under the control of the Skipper and/or Crew. All sailing's are subject **to weather conditions and water levels**, and if the Skipper feels it **is unsafe to sail the vessel** his instructions and orders shall be obeyed. These conditions are set **with your safety in mind**, and you and all members of your party must follow all instructions from the skipper. The Skipper and/or Crew can not be held responsible for **any unforeseen breakdown to the vessel**, weather conditions or water levels should the trip have to be cancelled. **Your Party will be allowed to board the vessel 15 minutes before departure, and the vessel will set sail on the given time on your booking form, if you wish to wait for any late arriving passengers the duration of the trip will be adjusted or additional payment required to extend the trip.**

In the case of catering & Barbecues if any members of your party do not arrive or cancel without 10 days notice the quoted price per head on your booking form will stand and the full amount must be paid.

Buffet & Barbecue Menus prices may vary for small parties please contact for quotes.

The vessel has a full bar facility on board with draft beers and is also equipped for catering, and the skipper and/or Crew have the right to refuse any party or passenger from boarding with any drinks or food purchased off the vessel.

C, Skipper's Liability

The Skipper and/or Crew will not be libel for any accident, injury, loss, damage to your party or any passengers caused by passenger negligence, and all safety regulations must be obeyed at all times.

D, The Hirer's Liability

The hirer shall be held liable for any loss or damage to the vessel or its equipment or fittings caused by them or any other passenger in the party.
